WHAT IS PROPOSED?

- A very large waste treatment plant between Pinkham Way (A406) and Muswell Hill Golf Course
 - Plant in operation 24 hours a day, 365 days a year
 - 1000+ lorry movements a day
- Run by private, commercially driven companies, contract of 25+ years
 - Gas may be stored on the site
 - Nothing to stop its future expansion
- Very recent changes to Haringey planning strategy allow for incineration to happen at this site in the future
 - Site will include a Barnet vehicle depot (in Haringey)



WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR US?

- Potentially dangerous air pollution
 - Unpleasant odour
 - Increased noise pollution
- Increased traffic congestion - North Circular bottleneck, Colney Hatch Lane, local rat-runs, Tesco, etc
- Destruction of a site of recognised ecological importance
 - A huge building (20m+ high) with possible chimney dominating the landscape
 - A reduction in our quality of life and property values
